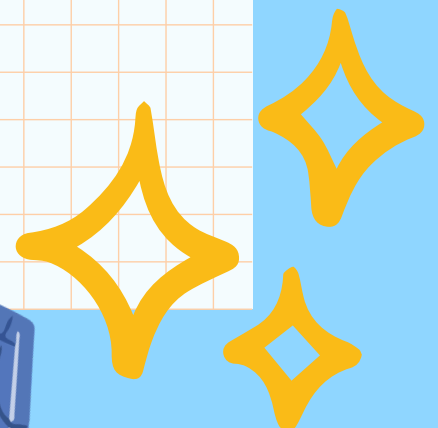
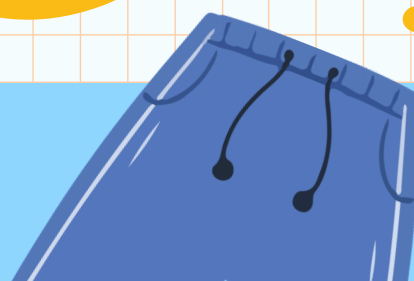
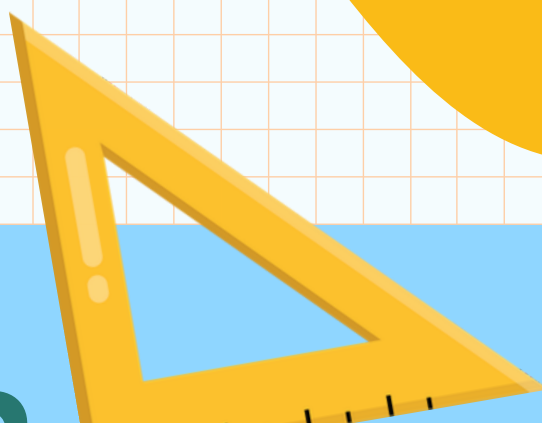
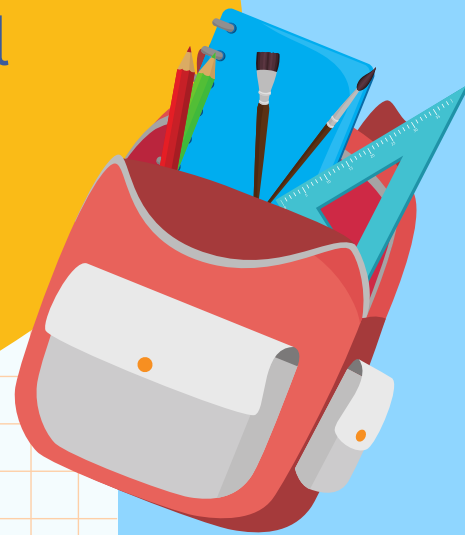
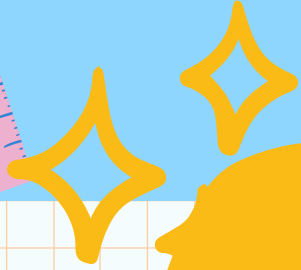
SCHOOL UNIFORM DONATIONS
